The aim of the Try Scouts badge is to encourage Cub Scouts, who are 10 years of age, to interact with their local Scout Troop by trying Scout Section activities both at Pack and Troop level. The badge does not replace the Scout Link Badge. The badge is approved by the Troop Council and awarded by the Patrol Leader participating with the Cub Scout.

The badge will be presented at the end of the last activity. The badge can be worn on the right shoulder of the Cub Scout uniform.
